

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A "TREE CITY USA" BOARD

Section 1. There is hereby created and established a Tree City USA Board for the City of Nashville, Arkansas which shall consist of 4 members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the City Council.

Section 2. The term of the persons to be appointed by the Mayor shall be 3 years, except that the term of 2 of the members appointed to the first board shall be for only one year and the term of two of the members shall be for 2 years. In the event of that a vacancy shall occur during the term of any member, his or her successor shall be appointed for the unexpired portion of the term.


Section 3. Members of the Board shall serve without compensation.

Section 4: The Board shall hold regular meetings and may call special meetings if necessary to carry out its duties. Minutes of the meetings shall be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk.


Section 5: The responsibility of the Board shall be to study, investigate, consult, develop, update annually, and administer a written plan of the care, preservation, pruning, planting or removal of trees and shrubs in parks, along streets, and in other public areas. Such plan will be presented annually to the City Council and upon their acceptance and approval shall constitute the official comprehensive tree management plan.

Section 6: The Board will encourage and foster the planting of trees and other vegetation for the beautification of the City of Nashville; and disseminate information to the public concerning proper care and selection of trees.


