Agreement Provisions

- 1) To obtain, prior to operation of said equipment, and continue in effect, for the duration of this agreement, public liability and property damage insurance in the amount required by State law to cover the operation of said equipment.
- 2) To provide the Commission with a copy or certificate of said liability insurance prior to operation of said equipment.
- 3) To insure that add on tanks, pumps, hose reels, etc., will not cause the vehicle in this agreement to exceed the G.V.W. of that vehicle. Add on tanks shall be baffled.
- 4) To operate said equipment, at no cost to the State.
- 5) To respond with said equipment, adequately manned, to all fire calls within 5 miles response distance of the fire station. Unless covered by another department.
- 6) To otherwise, equip, outfit, paint and place said equipment in active fire service within a six-month period from the date of delivery. If unable to meet this time frame, you must contact the Rural Fire Protection Coordinator's office in writing requesting an extension within 10 days of the deadline.
- 7) The color of the vehicle when painted shall be red, white or yellow.
- 8) You must keep all correspondence on equipment for 5 years from the time of acquiring the property, and make all paperwork available for inspection.
- 9) If equipment is to be disposed of, you must contact the Rural Fire Protection Coordinator's office in writing.
- 10) You must ensure that the program is not misused or abused in any way.
- 11) You must sign the attached DMV form 10-381 which gives the Commission authorization to have the title placed in your department's name.
- 12) The title will be held by the Commission until the equipment is placed in service. Then the title will be mailed to your department.

DOD Firefighter Program Vehicles

The new DOD Firefighter Program is a much different program than the older Federal Excess Personal Property Program. All participants need to be aware of the differences in the programs and the differences in the vehicles. Firefighter Program vehicles are not inspected before pickup due to the numbers going through the program. They are titled to the department as soon as they are located. Title changes are difficult after that point.

1. All vehicles are screened by computer pictures and descriptions and could have major problems. When we pick them up, we try to make sure they will start and load on our trailer, but this is not always possible. Many are good vehicles. However, a few may have irreparable problems. If you obtain one with major problems, a request must be submitted in writing to the Rural Fire Protection Office for the ability to sell or dispose of the vehicle due to excessive costs of repairs.
2. The AFC Rural Fire Protection Office recommends that upon arrival to pick up a DOD vehicle, check it over carefully. It is strongly recommended a trailer is brought to haul the vehicle instead of driving it to your destination. Bent drive shafts from loading and transferring vehicles at the DRMOs can be repaired for approximately \$125. However, if they are driven home, the transmission can be ruined resulting in thousands of dollars for repairs. Fluids in some vehicles may be low or drained, filters stopped up or missing, causing major failures. It is recommended all vehicles be hauled to your location and then inspected.

Since these vehicles through the DOD Firefighter Program become the property of the fire department when picked up, the department is responsible for repairs and fluid checks. RFP receives two to three times as many vehicles through this program in comparison to the FEPP program, and is unable to inspect all as previously done in the past.
