TRANSPORTATION TRAFFIC PLAN

Upon receipt of a request from a Volunteer Fire Department requesting a tanker truck, a survey of the transportation system of their district is required. The Fire Department will need to locate and catalog all of the bridges in their service area. Each county has or can obtain a Bridge Number Map from the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department. This map has all county roads and bridges numbered. The Highway Department also has a print-out titled: Bridge Inventory/Posting Certification which every County Judge must sign for his bridges to be certified. From these two pieces of information any bridge that has posted weight limit signs can be identified and the limitations of the bridge noted. This information is updated annually on all posted bridges. With this information the Fire Department can make an adequate traffic plan for their service area. By following these recommendations the fire department can pre-plan alternative routes for heavy tankers. Also, the weight of the truck will be posted on the dashboard and readily visible when approaching a posted bridge.

LOAN AGREEMENT PROVISIONS

- (1) To obtain, prior to operation of said equipment, and continue in effect, for the duration of this agreement, public liability and property damage insurance in the amount required by State law to cover the operation of said equipment.
- (2) To provide the COMMISSION with a copy or certificate of said liability insurance prior to operation of said equipment.
- (3) To insure that add on tanks, pumps, hose reels, etc., will not cause the vehicle in this agreement to exceed the G.V.W. of that vehicle. Add on tanks shall be baffled at each 125 gal. Interval.
- (4) To operate said equipment, at no cost to the State.
- (5) To respond with said equipment, adequately manned, to all fire calls within five (5) miles response distance of the fire station.
- (6) To otherwise equip, outfit, paint and place said equipment in active fire service within a six-month period from the date of delivery and provide shelter adequate to protect it from vandalism and/or the elements. Color of vehicle when painted shall be red, white, or yellow.
- (7) All equipment is limited to fire use and/or fire related activities.

LIABILITY & JUNKING CLAUSES

- (1) Title to the equipment shall remain with the Federal Government.
- (2) The equipment may not be sold, junked or traded, but must be returned to the COMMISSION for final disposition.
- (3) When equipment is returned upon termination of this agreement, said equipment shall have at least the same component parts as it had when the COOPERATOR received said equipment.
- (4) The equipment will be marked with a Rural Fire Decal on each door, that will indicate the cooperation between the COOPERATOR and the COMMISSION.
